Finally, a raucous late night dance party that won't disturb the neighbors — because the music is all in the partygoers' heads.

Revelers will dance to their own beat Saturday night in Williamsburg as three DJs will spin discs that can only be heard through headphones.

It's the latest "Quiet Clubbing" event hosted by Will Petz, who's thrown about 30 such events over the last seven months. In this case, the Greenpoint Chamber of Commerce was looking for a fun event with a view of the Manhattan skyline that wouldn't disturb any residents, he said.

"You're in your own world, but you're still part of something," said Petz. "You feel comfortable to sing because no one can hear you - it's like you're in the shower."

The DJs will play a mix of hip hop and Top 40 pop. Different colored lights on the headphones indicate which channel people are dancing to.

"You own the DJ," said Petz. "The DJs can see if people aren't tuned into to them. They know they have to switch it up."
